STOPPAGE OF INTERIM APPROVAL OF PROGRAMMES

The Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority (TVETA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Education established under the TVET ACT CAP 210A of 2013. Among the functions of the Authority as stated in Section 7 of TVET ACT CAP 210A of 2013 is to accredit, register and license TVET institutions, trainers and programmes in Kenya.

The Authority has occasionally been granting interim approval of assessment centers for courses in cases where an institution has candidates for a specific assessment series. Section 17(3) of the TVET Act requires that no course shall be mounted in an institution without approval by the Authority. Further, section 19(1) of the Act requires the TVETA Board to finalize approval process.

In order to ensure quality training in accordance with Section 17 of the TVET Act CAP 210A, the Authority will no longer be issuing interim approvals. Institutions are therefore advised to apply for licensing of courses early enough to allow for timely inspection and approval.

TVET Authority therefore guides that institutions submit their request for approval of assessment centers for specific assessment series as indicated in the table below.
